WHOLE HEALTH

At both admission and discharge, we assess the Whole Health of the individual served. The Thompson Whole Health Assessment combines questions regarding Social Determinants of Health (food, housing, transportation, interpersonal safety) and Well-being Scale – on an individual, family, and community level.
