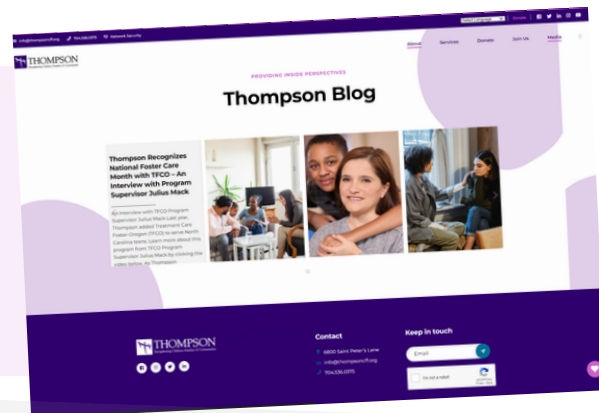

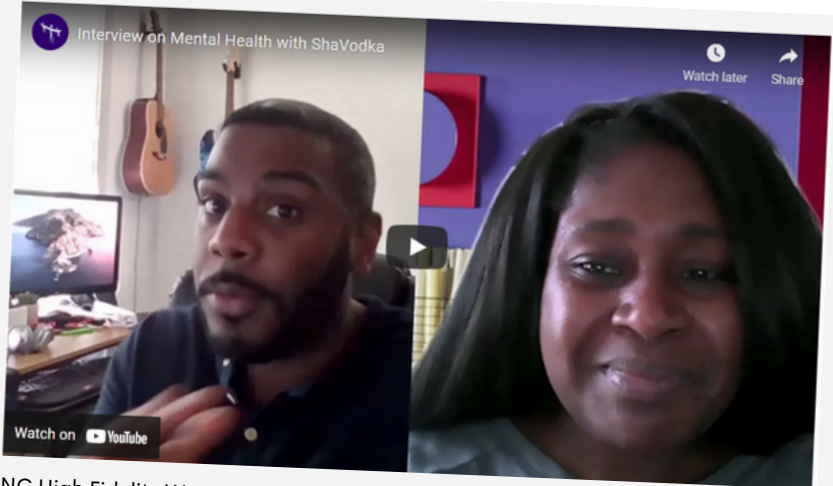

## Mental Health

- Our blog also focuses on the importance of mental health in an [interview](#) with [Wraparound](#) Program Director ShaVodka Nowacki.
- Our [Crisis Stabilization program](#) expanded - as a [third cottage opened](#) and began serving youth.
- Additional [Family Centered Treatment](#) practitioners have been recruited to expand caseload potential.
- **91% of families report improvement** in handling of daily life and related challenges in our [Intensive In-Home](#) program (FYTD).
- [Psychiatric Residential Treatment](#) clients reported **88% client satisfaction**, with **88% of youth reporting they feel better able to manage their emotions** than when they first came to Thompson.
