Mental Health

- 96% client satisfaction for Family Centered Therapy (FCT) in April.
- <u>High-Fidelity Wraparound</u> expanded its reach, supporting four teams serving 11 counties. Their clients achieved 94% mental health gains and 97% client satisfaction.
- 100% of <u>Outpatient Mental Health Services</u> clients reported a positive relationship with their therapist FY 22/23.







- The School at Thompson held its open house April 17th.
- 93% of youth expressed satisfaction with the program, and 100% reported that they had positive relationships with more than one staff member at Thompson.
- 93% of youth have not required a higher level of care within 6 months of their successful discharge in FY 22/23.

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
