Family Stability

- <u>Family Education</u> achieved 95% client satisfaction; <u>Family Partners</u> achieved 100% client satisfaction.
- <u>Foster Care</u> had 95% placement stability and 100% Foster Parent satisfaction.
- <u>Friends of the Children Charlotte</u> achieved 100% youth satisfaction & 98% caregiver satisfaction.
- 91% of <u>Thompson Placement Stability Unit</u> youth maintained a stable placement. 100% of youth did not experience a placement disruption as a result of their behavior, and 100% achieved their desired goals.

🖄 Mental Health

- 100% of <u>Intensive In-Home (IIH)</u> clients experienced mental health gains.
- 100% of <u>Family Centered Therapy (FCT)</u> clients were discharged to the same or a lower level of care, and had no new legal charges or CPS involvement filed.
- 100% of <u>Multisystemic Therapy (MST)</u> youth were living at home and attending school at the close of treatment.
- <u>School-Based Mental Health</u> achieved 100% client satisfaction and 100% mental health gains.

Residential



- The Crisis Stabilization unit in Fayetteville is officially opened and will be serving clients any day.
- 100% of Crisis Stabilization youth at our Matthews campus were discharged to a long-term placement, and 100% maintained their placement and were not placed in psychiatric treatment.
- Thompson will be presenting at the i2i Conference, discussing the success of our <u>Enhanced Residential</u> <u>Treatment Center (ERTC)</u> – prioritizing stability for youth and their families, resulting in less repeat stays and continuing services in aftercare, resulting in both caregivers and youth being set up for successful home environment reunification.

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
