## **Farly Childhood**

- <u>Thompson Child Development Center</u> (TCDC) parents expressed 99% client satisfaction.
- The TCDC Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) will have a Fall Festival in October. Volunteer opportunities available!



# **Family Stability**

- <u>Family Education</u> achieved 97% client satisfaction; <u>Family Partners</u> achieved 100% Family Functioning Gains.
- <u>Foster Care</u> had 82% mental health gains and 100% Foster Home (youth) satisfaction.
- <u>Friends of the Children Charlotte</u> achieved 100% youth satisfaction and 99% caregiver satisfaction.
- <u>School-Based Case Management</u> achieved 100% client satisfaction and 80% self-sufficiency gains.

### 🖄 Mental Health

- 100% of <u>Family Centered Therapy (FCT)</u> clients were discharged to the same or a lower level of care and had no new legal charges or CPS involvement filed.
- 100% of <u>Multisystemic Therapy (MST)</u> youth were living at home and attending school at the close of treatment.
- <u>School-Based Mental Health</u> achieved 100% client satisfaction and 83% mental health gains.

## 🐼 Residential

- The average Child & Adolescent Functional Assessment Scale (CAFAS) score, measuring the degree of behavioral & emotional impairment for youth in our Crisis Stabilization Program, decreased from intake to discharge each month over the last year.
- 100% of youth in our <u>Enhanced Residential</u> <u>Treatment Center (ERTC)</u> experienced mental health gains.
- 100% of youth discharging from PRTF showed a reduction in incidents from intake to discharge.
