


Enhanced Residential Treatment Center



Enhanced Residential Treatment prioritizes family functioning and aftercare to prevent repeat stays for youth with significant behavioral health challenges. Enhanced Residential Treatment provides a shorter stay (up to 120 days) program for youth and provides families with the skills needed for a successful reunification and to support the youth in their home environment. Enhancements in discharge planning will include <u>Family Centered Treatment (FCT)</u> and <u>High-Fidelity Wraparound (HFW)</u> services.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- Serves male youth ages 11-17 years
- FCT stays are typically 30-45 days; HFW 60-120 days
- 24/7 nursing and support staff
- Individualized treatment plans and psychiatric care
- The School at Thompson provides one-on-one and small group instruction
- Individual, group, and family therapy
- CARE Program Model, Therapeutic Crisis Intervention
- Family Support Partners as advocates for the family

- Licensed clinicians trained in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), & Family Centered Treatment (FCT)
- Treatment team works alongside the <u>Family Centered</u>
 <u>Treatment</u> team, <u>High Fidelity Wraparound</u> team, and
 the youth's family to ensure they are prepared and
 equipped for discharge to ensure positive outcomes
- Optional spiritual support
- Nationally Accredited through Joint Commission
