overview


The Enhanced Residential Treatment Center (ERTC) prioritizes family functioning and aftercare to prevent repeat stays for youth with significant behavioral health challenges. ERTC provides a shorter stay (up to 120 days) for youth and provides families with the skills needed for a successful reunification and to support the youth in their home environment.

Enhancements in discharge planning will include Family Centered Treatment (FCT) and High-Fidelity Wraparound (HFW) services.

outcomes







goals

- Increased family engagement and participation in services and treatment
- Decreased severity of problematic behavior
- Increased youth mental health functioning
- Improved family functioning



how we serve

Shorter (up to 120 days) residential stays with enhanced discharge support.

- 24/7 nursing and support staff
- Individual, group, and family therapy
- CARE Program Model, Therapeutic Crisis Intervention
- Family Support Partners advocate for the family
- Licensed clinicians trained in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), & Family Centered Treatment (FCT)
- Treatment team works alongside the Family Centered Treatment team, High Fidelity Wraparound team, and the youth's family to ensure they are prepared and equipped for discharge to ensure positive outcomes.

- Adolescents ages 11 to 17 often highly traumatized youth
- Youth struggling with behavioral disorders or in need of added support











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
